AMENDED ORDER ON PROTECTIVE FACIAL COVERINGS AND SOCIAL
DISTANCING

WHEREAS, the Marion Circuit and Superior Courts have implemented operational changes in response to the COVID-19 public health emergency over the two years including an Order on Protective Facial Coverings and Six (6) Foot Distancing issued on February 16, 2022 and

WHEREAS, the Marion Circuit Court Judge and Marion Superior Court Executive Committee Judges, jointly, find it is in the best interests of the public and employees and now FINDS, and ORDERS as follows:

- (1) The City-County Building, Juvenile Justice Complex, and Community Justice Center are all considered a “Courthouse.”
- (2) All individuals entering the Courthouse are encouraged to follow CDC guidelines regarding appropriate mask wearing and social distancing based on their own personal vaccination status and health situation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that effective March 9, 2022, the previous protective facial coverings and social distancing orders are amended for all Courthouse facilities.
