ORDER ON PROTECTIVE FACIAL COVERINGS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING

WHEREAS, the Marion Circuit and Superior Courts have implemented operational changes in response to the COVID-19 public health emergency over the 20 months, including an original Order on Protective Facial Coverings and Six (6) Foot Distancing issued on June 9, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Marion Circuit and Superior Courts rescinded said order on November 17, 2021 in light of improved health conditions in Marion County and the availability of vaccines to all individuals over the age of 12; and

WHEREAS, the number of COVID-19 cases in Marion County has risen significantly due in part to the fast-spreading Omicron variant and the county is now in the "high risk" category by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC") for disease transmission; and

WHEREAS, the Marion Circuit Court Judge and Marion Superior Court Executive Committee Judges, jointly, find it is in the best interests of the public and employees and now FINDS, and ORDERS as follows:

- (1) The City-County Building, the Juvenile Justice Complex, and the Marion Superior Court Probation office located at 2525 N. Shadeland Avenue are all considered a "Courthouse."
- (2) All individuals aged two (2) and older are required to wear protective facial coverings properly by covering the nose and mouth while in one of the Courthouse facilities. Facial coverings shall be provided in the event an individual does not have his own before entering the Courthouse facilities.
- (3) Capacity in each public space of the Courthouse shall be limited to 50% capacity.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that effective January 7, 2022, the Marion County Sheriff shall enforce this Order complying with ADA requirements. This Order shall remain in effect until further order by the Marion Circuit Court.
